This office has recently completed an audit of Transport Workers Local Union 2035 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you on May 16, 2005, the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The CAP disclosed that the union filed a deficient annual financial report with the Secretary of Labor which failed to meet the standards of acceptability in violation of LMRDA Section 201(b). You agreed to file an amended LM-3 report which has been received in this Office. Therefore, no further action is necessary.
