Dear Mr. Harriman:

This office has recently completed an audit of Painters DC 35 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959, as Amended (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you, on November 8, 2005, the following problems were discussed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The CAP disclosed that the District Council did not properly categorize officer expenses. The officer expenses were reported but not attributed to the individual officers. As agreed, the LM report for fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 will be filed with the appropriate classification of officer expenses within 30 days of the November 8th meeting.
