This office has recently completed an audit of Steelworkers Local 12-9475 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you and Financial Secretary Glenn Brunsell on August 30, 2005, the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The CAP disclosed there was a missing receipt for labels purchased from ULINE for \$105.00. This was resolved when the vendor faxed a copy of the receipt to the union for my review. The CAP also disclosed that there were a number of deficiencies in the LM-3 Report for FYE 12/31/2004. These deficiencies were corrected on August 30, 2005 when the union filed an acceptable Amended LM Report for that period.
