This office has recently completed an audit of Teamsters Local 421 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you on October 20, 2005, the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The CAP disclosed a violation of Section 201(a) of the Act when it was determined that the local had failed to file amendments to its bylaws with the Secretary. As discussed, changes and or amendments to your bylaws should be filed with the local's LM-2 report at the end of each fiscal year. A current copy of the local's bylaws was furnished during the CAP and no further action is necessary.
