This office has recently completed an audit of Security Police and Fire Professionals of America (SPFPA) Local 5 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA).
